Minimum Eligibility Requirements For Entry-Level Firefighter Paramedic:

- 1. Must possess a high school diploma or a GED
- 2. Must be a citizen of the United States of America.
- 3. Must possess a valid driver's license.
- 4. Must be physically and mentally fit to perform the full duties of a Firefighter/Paramedic.
- 5. Must have completed Essentials of Firefighting certification and be a practicing Paramedic.

Minimum Eligibility Requirements For Entry-Level Police Officer:

- 1. Must possess a High School Diploma or a GED.
- 2. Must have 60 credit hours of post-secondary education. Applicant may substitute 750 hours of law enforcement experience for each 15 credit hours of post-secondary education. Supporting documentation must be submitted with application.
- 3. Must be a citizen of the United States of America.
- **4.** Must possess a valid driver's license.
- **5.** Must be physically and mentally fit to perform the full duties of a police officer.
- 6. Must have completed Act 120 training and be current with training updates to within 12 months of application deadline.
