



The Luzerne Conservation District (LCD) will be conducting truck mounted ultra-low volume (ULV) mosquito control operations next week in the following municipalities: Plains Township, Plymouth Township, Plymouth Borough, Swoyersville Borough, Larksville Borough, Edwardsville Borough, Kingston Borough, Forty Fort Borough, West Wyoming Borough, Wyoming Borough and Exeter Borough, Luzerne County. Residential and recreational areas will be sprayed for adult mosquitoes. These sprays will happen on Monday, June 30th and Tuesday, July 1st, 2025 and will begin around 8:30pm. If residents of municipalities in the treatment area could limit their time outside after this time, this will allow the District to have more effective coverage. High populations of nuisance mosquitoes were collected in the affected area and numerous complaints were received by residents triggering these control operations.

The truck mounted ULV spray will be conducted by LCD. The business license for LCD is BU 11113. The product that will be used is AquaDuet, applied at a rate of .62 oz/ac. This product is designed to provide quick knockdown and effective control of adult mosquitoes.

Weather conditions and other unexpected events could delay or cancel this spray operation. Wednesday, July 2, 2025 will be used as a rain date or to continue operations if necessary. Please contact Lauren Holder at 570-674-7991 ext. 9 if you have any questions or concerns.
