ORDINANCE 2023 – 1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF KINGSTON, LUZERNE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, A HOME RULE MUNICIPALITY, AMENDING SECTION 170 – 25 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Kingston has heretofore enacted various ordinances as amended from time to time, to promote and provide for the regulation of vehicular traffic and traffic safety within the Municipality; and,

WHEREAS, the Municipality has experienced difficulty with the safe passage of municipal service vehicles and emergency service vehicles in the blocks of Myers Lane between Penn Street and Brewster Lane.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that the Town Council of the Municipality of Kingston does hereby amend Municipal Code Section 170 – 25 to add the following to the designated no parking areas on municipal streets:

- 1. Myers Lane East side from the intersection of Penn Street with Myers Lane for a distance of 441 feet to the intersection of Myers Lane and Brewster Lane.
- 2. The provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable, and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, clauses or phrases of this Ordinance, but the same shall remain in full force and effect, it being the intent that this Ordinance shall stand, notwithstanding the invalidity of any part thereof.
- 3. This Ordinance shall become effective as provided by Sections 212 and 213 of the Charter of the Municipality of Kingston.
